Preparing the Works Cited list:

- 1. <u>Organization</u> Collect information for your **Works Cited** entries as you do your research don't leave this to the end. Every work you take words, ideas, images, audio, etc. from must be included in your **Works Cited** list.
- Order List entries in alphabetical order. Ignore A, An or The if it is the first word in the citation. Information within the entries must also follow the correct order.
- 3. <u>Spacing</u> double space the **Works Cited** list and use "hanging" indentation (indent second and subsequent lines about 1 cm or 1 tab).
- 4. <u>Punctuation</u> follow the correct format, as in the examples below.
- 5. Missing information
 - a. No author begin with the next piece of information, e.g., Title
 - b. No place of publication, no publisher use N.p.
 - c. No pagination use N. pag.
 - d. No date use N.d.
- 6. <u>Dates</u>
 - a. use most current copyright date or last updated date
 - b. day, month and year, e.g., today's date would be written ____
 - c. cite both publication date and access date for web resources
- 7. <u>Uniform Resource Locator</u> (URL) Include this if you think someone else would not be able to find it if you don't list it,or if your teacher requires it (5.6.1)
