Only two groups per class may work on the same topic, in the event of a conflict, the group with the higher average Term 2 mark takes precedence.

Presentation 11" x 17" poster, Max 22" x 17" students may use cardboard or construction paper.

Must have a minimum of: 10 facts & 6 images on the topic, and each fact and/or image must be cited with each source properly referenced. Works cited shall include a minimum of 3 print sources, 2 database sources. No more than 3 facts or images may be from a single web site. Images must have a caption and attribution below each image, referring to the Works Cited.
