Geography/Government Project

This project is a way review important concepts that are presented in the Geography and Government Unit. There is a choice of three possibilities (with teacher approval):

1. Choose a nation and research demographic, government and recent current events information pertaining the nation. You will be required to show demographic information highlighting major issues and information about development as well as structure of government.
2. Choose one of the major 5 ideologies. Research thoroughly the beginnings, development and currently how the ideology has been put into practice. How has the ideology affected Canada (past, present, current).
3. Choose one of the major political parties in federal or BC provincial politics. Research thoroughly the beginnings, past, present and current issues regarding the political party.

The information is to be presented to the class in a short 5 minutes informative lesson. Each student will have a PowerPoint hand out of the slides for each student. You will also be required to submit an infographic that shows your learning. The area of the infographic must be no larger than a 11X17 sheet of paper single sided or the format may be a pamphlet.

There will be a variety of evaluations:

Presentation:

- 10 Peer Evaluation
- 10 Teacher Evaluation

Infographic/pamphlet:

- 10 PowerPoint handout
- 10 Depth and breadth of information
- 10 Effective use of visuals

- 10 Use of proper citation on both presentation and infographic.
