Policies and Procedures:

The following are in addition to the policies and procedures detailed in the student agenda.

Attendance: If absent check with your teacher at tutorial! It is your responsibility to find out what you missed and make it up.

Attendance is recorded and reported for each class. Chronic absenteeism can significantly impact student learning and progress.

- Students returning to school after an absence are expected to fill out an absence note (available in the office or on the school website

<u>http://go.vsb.bc.ca/schools/kitsilano/Publications/ABSENCE%20NOTE%20FORM.pdf</u>) This note must be shown to all subject teachers whose classes were missed, and should include the student's name, student number, dates and times when absent. The note should then be turned into the office. This policy is in place to comply with Vancouver School Board Regulations regarding attendance.

- Students wishing an early dismissal from school must bring a note signed by their parent/guardian. The student should show the subject teacher the note and then report to the office to sign out.

- Students who take extended vacations do so without the endorsement of the school. Families are encouraged to plan vacations for the scheduled school breaks as absences can impact student learning and progress.

- Students going on field trips must have signed permission from their parent/guardian. Teachers whose classes are being missed should sign the form also.

Cellphone policy: Cellphone use will not be allowed in the classroom without explicit permission. Please leave cellphones in your bags and on silent while in class.

Use of a cellphone in class without permission may result in the cellphone being confiscated until the end of the class or the end of the school day.

Punctuality: Students are expected to arrive on time. Activities missed at the beginning of class may result in a loss of marks. Students arriving late for a test or quiz, may not be given extra time. Students who are frequently late may be required to make up the time at the teacher's discretion.

Academic Integrity Policy:

On First Offence

- The student will receive "0" for that particular work.
- The incident will be recorded on the student's discipline file.
- The parents/guardians may be informed.
- The student will not be eligible for Honour Roll recognition.

On Second Offence

In addition to all first offence consequences:

- The student will not be eligible for school-based scholarships.
- The student will be referred to Grade Administrator.

Assignments: It is your responsibility to have your assignments completed accurately and on time. Late assignments will be accepted but may not be marked until the end of the term.

Lab Safety: Students must be aware of all safety rules and practices. Follow all instruction during labs. No food or drinks!

Extra help: Available during morning tutorial or by appointment.
